














TCOES Functional Highlights

Responsible for Technical Activities outreach, engagement, and membership topics

- Focusing on membership and engagement across all of TA
- Centralizing efforts in these areas



New Committee, began meeting in September 2022

Provides focused group to address topics that were previously individual ad hoc efforts

Committee functions that will make a difference for you:

- Address higher level systemic issues that impact all Societies/Councils (including all Chapters of all Societies/Councils)
- Improve capacity for communication and engagement between all parts of IEEE (e.g., Regions and Sections) and parts of TA like Societies and Councils
- Improve opportunities for members (including groups like YP, Industry, etc.) and the value of membership
- Share knowledge and Best Practices globally across Societies/Councils
- Listen to members and leaders across the organization





TAB Membership and Engagement Forums

First ever Forum held December 2022



Major Themes from December 2022 Forum:

- Local engagement: Increased support for Chapters and Chapter collaboration
 - Student to young professional/higher grade transition: Tracking movement through transition: messaging, offers, benefits
- **Industry engagement**: Identifying needs of individuals and companies
- Society/Council collaboration: Continuing the dialogue from the Forum / future connections
- Providing support for the S/C Membership role: Sharing best practices; Data access, tools, and data usage

Held second TAB Membership and Engagement Forum in April 2023, with Breakout Sessions on:

- Increasing Engagement with/of Students
- Increasing Engagement with/of Recent Graduates (transition from Student to Young Professional)
- Increasing Engagement with/of Industry
