

IEEE Region 10 Annual General Meeting 4-5 March 2023, Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam

Minutes of Meeting

The 2023 Region 10 Annual General Meeting was held on 4-5 March 2023 in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam. This is the first face-to-face R10 AGM since the last physical AGM in 2019, Melbourne. There were a total of 105 participants attending the meeting in person, comprising of 30 EXCOM members, 48 primary delegates and 13 secondary delegates from the R10 Sections and Councils, 3 Subsection Chairs, 6 guests and 5 staff. There were 8 participants attending this meeting online, including the IEEE Executive Director and Chief Operating Officer, Ms Sophia Muirhead.



Day 1 – 4 March 2023

The formal Region 10 Annual meeting began with the roll call of all the attendees, and R10 Secretary confirmed a quorum. R10 Past Director Deepak Mathur presided over a minute of silence that was held as a mark of respect for our senior R10 leaders, Prof Lawrence Wong, Prof BG Park and Mr Amarnath Raja, who passed away in 2022.

The agenda was presented on the screen, it was previously distributed to all the delegates. R10 Director Lance Fung asked for approval. The Meeting approved the agenda without objection.

R10 Director welcomed the invited guests. He also congratulated IEEE VP Elect Deepak Mathur and thank the Vietnam Section Chair, Professor Tuan Don-Hong for hosting the 2023 R10 Annual Meeting in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam. He introduced the team and the Ad Hoc committees R10 focus will be on the members, volunteers and leaders and the challenge will be the retention of members, especially students. He elaborated the R10 key activities will be on the Region Realignment which was passed during Nov IEEE Board of Directors. He talked about the need to have diversity and inclusion, the important of ethical behaviour and climate change. He will form working groups on Global Energy Interconnection to work on cross border energy transfer as requested by the IEEE President. He briefly mentioned the three R10 flagship conference TENSYP, HTC and TENCON, and other activities in the coming months, such as R10Talk, R10 Robotic Competition and CLAP.

In his address, IEEE President Saifur Rahman talked about his focus - innovate, coordinate, communicate and co-operate. He also mentioned the IEEE areas of focus - Member, Technology, Education, Standards and Climate Change. There are Ad Hoc committees set up to look into climate change, multimedia-based digital reality technology, president-elect campaign and innovative funding

models. Lastly, he talked about the Section and Chapter leaders who are our dedicated volunteers supporting the local communities.

IEEE Present-Elect Tom Coughlin shared his priorities for 2024 which include increase outreach to younger members, increase engagement with industry, increase outreach to the broader public and investing on new products and services. He cited the achievements of IEEE where its publications are cited 3 times more than any other publications in the top 50 patenting organisations, IEEE members have won 21 Nobel prizes, and filed over 143000 patents in 2022. IEEE has over 1300 active standards and publishes 3 out of the top 5 publications on AI, Automation and Control Systems, and Computer Science.

Next, it was Q&As session for the IEEE President, President-Elect and R10 Director.

- What can the IEEE volunteer leaders give to the political leaders?
Saifur answered that we should not talk or write policies for political issues.
- How can we celebrate success?
We can take part in organizing conference and engage with local mayor office, and taking part in climate change working groups.
- There is a question about YP membership dues.
Tom emphasized that the value is for YP to participate in IEEE activities.
- How can we engage the industry?
Lance answered that R10 has the Industry Relations Committee to engage the industry practitioners.
- Is hybrid meeting still necessary?
Lance said meetings are still essential and we can still have diverse ways of meetings.

IEEE Executive Director Sophia Muirhead gave her address virtually. She talked about societally sustainable digital transformation to protect children online privacy. She also shared her 2023 Executive Director goals, the key risks as macroeconomic factors, geopolitical risks, changing customer expectations, talent acquisition and retention, declining revenue if dues are cut, cyber security and the key opportunities such as the new U.S Climate Law, Chips Act, and Innovate and Experiment. She will continue to advance mission, vision and core values of IEEE.

This is followed by the Region 2 Director address, Andrew Lowery, who spoke broadly about the roles and responsibilities of a Region Director and shared R2's priorities and priority projects for 2023 which includes support for local activities, financial transparency and growth, engagement of students and YP, and leadership and volunteering opportunities. He also provided an update on the merging of Regions 1 and 2.

IEEE Vice President, MGA Jill Gostin talked about the MGA initiatives and priorities for 2023. She updated the Region Realignment status. Her plans for 2023:

- Continue forward momentum of Region Realignment
- Follow-through and track progress on 2023 Priority Projects
- Prepare for and execute a successful Sections Congress
- Encourage Regions to consider plans for surplus projects (due April 8)
- Optimize and focus MGA committees on specific goals, especially focused on support of local volunteers
- Continue pilots and track success
- Improve collaborations with other IEEE major Organizational Units (OUs)
- Review communications with, training of, and tools for volunteers

Jill also presented on behalf of Cecelia Jankowski, Managing Director, MGA on MGA and Membership. It was found that membership dues don't affect much on membership growth.

R10 Director-Elect Takako Hashimoto presented the Robert's Rules of Orders for fair and orderly meetings where everyone should have the right to speak once and only urgent matters should interrupt the speaker.

R10 Secretary reported on the R10 EXCOM Meeting held on 7 January 2023 in Bangkok, Thailand. The minutes of the previous R10 Annual Meeting was presented on the screen. This meeting minutes was distributed to the attendees prior to the meeting and there were no issues with it. The motion to accept the minutes was unanimously approved.

After lunch, the meeting resumed with 2 Training Workshops:

- Technical Program Management by SM Sameer and Michael Ong
- Sections/Chapters Formation and Reporting Policies by Amit Kumar

Past R10 Treasurer Rajendra Jadeja presented the financial report for 2022. This was followed by the Audit Committee Chair Seishi Takamura confirmation that all income and expenses are clearly and accurately reflected, and requested the motion for the approval of the financial report. It was approved by the attendees. R10 Treasurer shared the details of 2023 budget and provided the steps to seek reimbursement for R10 AGM 2023 via Concur. She also provided details to seek expense reimbursement for the delegates attending Sections Congress 2023 for both delegates covered by MGA, and by Region 10.

The next session was the presentation by the three R10 Activities Committees, namely the Membership, Professional and Technical Committees. The Vice-Chair of Membership Committee Preeti Bajaj provide the overviews of their 2023 activities. This was followed by the presentation the Committee Chairs:

The meeting then moved to recess for a coffee break together with the Poster Session where all the R10 EXCOM shared their workplans and projects interactively with the delegates.

After the break, the first presentation was from the Ethics Awareness & Advancement Committee Chair Sudeendra Koushik. It was followed by a presentation on Awareness on Ethics Education by Mousmi Ajay Chaurasia where she shared the operations of the IEEE Ethics and Member Conduct Committee. She also provided the IEEE Code of Ethics, ethics resources and organizations.

The R10 2023 Sections Congress Coordinator Michael Ong shared the important considerations for the Primary Section Delegates, Council Chairs and EXCOM members attending SC2023. He also provided the useful information on travel visa and FAQs. He requested the Section Chairs to submit the SC Recommendations to R10 for review and evaluation.

Lastly, we have Deepak the R10 Advisory & Nomination Chair to share the objectives of the committee. His committee will work on the transition in the Region Realignment. He also provided the details of positions in IEEE for whose nomination deadlines are coming up.

The Day 1 Meeting was adjourned at 5:40pm.

Day 2 – 5 March 2023

Day 2 meeting commenced with a follow-up talk by IEEE President, Saifur Rahman reiterated that we as IEEE volunteers should provide technological support policies to the organisations.

The invited speech on Cooperation with National Societies was presented by Peter Nagy. He gave the reason for signing an NSA:

- To create and encourage contact and cooperation
- To develop joint activities by the two organizations
- To make IEEE more visibility

This is followed by another invited talk by Mousmi Ajay Chaurasia on how to Upskill your Volunteer with IEEE CLE. She spoke about the Center for Leadership Excellence in great detail where there are more than 200 courses of which 61 are certified. There was a question on why the Section Chairs are not eligible to apply for VOLT which Mousmi replied that they can do so after their term as Section Chairs.

There was a comment by Past IEEE President and R10 Director Toshio Fukuda that TENSYP should be held in 1st half of the year and the R10 Conference Coordinator should ensure the timeline is maintained for R10 flagship events.

In the New Business/Other Matters session, the participants were invited to raise any questions or issues:

- Request to upload all presentations from the R10 Meet on to website.
- Lance responded that its already on the R10 website.
- Comment to advise on increased industry engagement and how can sections increase industry engagement and presence.
- Lance commented that this is an ongoing discussion and will be looked into.
- Comment that the YP and student attendance at 2022 SYWL was low where the focus needs to be on them.
- Lance commented that the R10 EXCOM already has a good representation of YPs, and we will continue to focus on the student-YP attendance. Nia responded that there was ample involvement of students and YP.
- Request to have more training programs/workshops at R10 Meet. This adds a lot of value.
- Lance commented that we might not have enough time for that at R10 Meets but it will be considered in future meetings.
- Request for grant for basic research from R10.
- R10 does not provide grants for research, its main focus is for the members.

There was no further business raised and the 2023 R10 Annual Meeting was adjourned at 12 noon, 5 March 2023.
