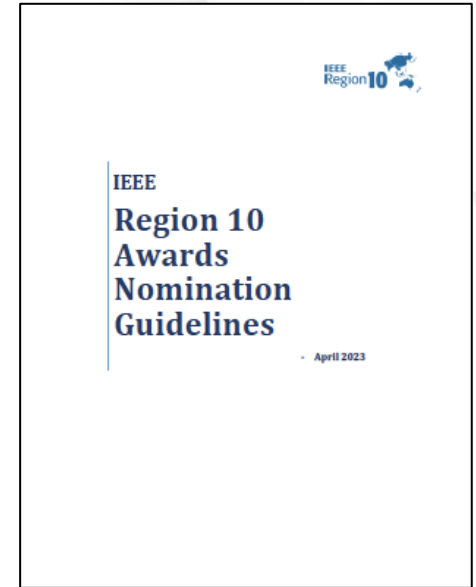

**To Host/ Organize IEEE R10 Flagship Conferences -
TENCON 2025, TENSYPM 2025 and R10-HTC 2025**

Important points about IEEE Region 10 Flagship Conferences

- TENCON is normally organized in September-November every year and it has broad areas of Electrical, Electronics and Computer Engineering. It was started in 1980.
- TENSYPM is normally organized in March-June every year and usually it has a specific area of Engineering and Technology, relevance to countries in the Asia-Pacific region. It was started in 2013.
- R10-HTC is normally organized in October-December every year. The aim is to promote discussions and development of Electrical, Communication, Computing, Security and Disaster Relief to present results of recent technology advancement in order to help improve lives of the impoverished.
- Seed money of USD 5,000 can be provided at beginning of the conference upon request and the amount needs to be returned to R10 after the completion of the conference. Any surplus/ profit generated from the conference must share with R10 on 70:30 (Host Section:R10) basis.
- Two MoUs need to be signed with the organizers: one with IEEE to upload the conference papers in IEEE Xplore and another with IEEE Region 10.

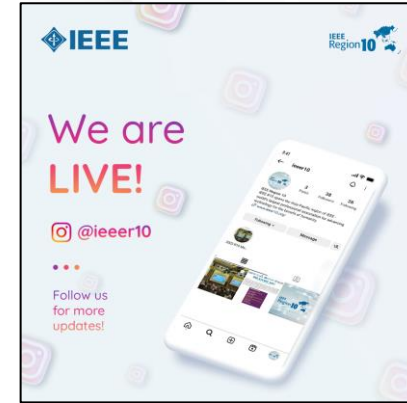
