Which makes it difficult for someone to get access to an International Transaction Enabled Credit Card. Also, the amount in a single transaction is limited. All of these made getting membership in COVID 19 pandemic even more difficult.

Another problem we faced is that due to the COVID 19 pandemic, our economy took a hit, especially for Young Professionals and WIE Professionals. So reduced fees for different IEEE Products for YP and WIE Members will help us in this situation.
