

# IEEE Region 10 Annual General Meeting 2-3 March 2024, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

## Minutes of Meeting

The 2024 Region 10 Annual General Meeting was held on 2-3 March 2024 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. There are 131 delegates in attendance, comprising of 35 EXCOM members and Ad Hoc committee chairs, 61 primary delegates and 13 secondary delegates from the R10 Sections and Councils, 2 Subsection Chairs, 1 observer, 12 invited guests and 7 staff.



### Day 1 – 2 March 2024

The formal Region 10 Annual meeting began with the roll call of all the attendees, and R10 Secretary Michael Ong confirmed a quorum. R10 Director Lance Fung welcomed all the delegates and invited guests. The meeting agenda was presented on the screen, it was previously distributed to all the delegates. R10 Director Lance Fung asked for approval. The Meeting approved the agenda without no abstains nor objections.

R10 Nominations and Advisory member Kukjin Chun presided over a minute of silence that was held as a mark of respect for our past R10 director, Dr Jung Uck Seo, who passed away in 2023. The motion for this Resolution was adopted for Region 10 to expresses its deepest sympathy to Dr Jung Uck Seo's family.

Next, we have the R10 Ethics and Enterprise Risks Management committee chair, Sudeendra Koushik to lead the ethics pledge.

R10 Secretary Michael Ong reported on the R10 Meeting held on 11 August 2023, in conjunction with the Sections Congress in Ottawa, Canada. The minutes of this R10 Meeting was presented on the

screen. This meeting minutes was distributed to the attendees prior to the meeting and there were no issues with it. The motion to accept the minutes was unanimously approved with no objections.

R10 Secretary also reported on the R10 EXCOM Meeting held on 6 January 2024 in Okinawa, Japan. The minutes of the previous R10 Annual Meeting was presented on the screen. This meeting minutes was distributed to the attendees prior to the meeting and there were no issues nor comments regarding this report.

In her address, IEEE President-Elect Kathleen Kramer briefly introduced herself and talked about her focus on Advancing Technology for Humanity through

- Better advance technology by including the organization's global and diverse members effectively and equitably in the process
- Improve the effectiveness and efficiency of IEEE while honoring its obligations to members

She also shared the IEEE Strategic Plan Refresh that is to ensure alignment, and in particular that the organisation unit and member input will be a priority.

IEEE Vice-President for Technical Activities Board, Fred shared his journey on finding his home in Member Geographic Activities and Technical Activities. He also talked about the 47 technical societies and councils and the programs, incubation, initiatives and resources available in TA. One of his focuses is to improve the Young Professionals experience and he is planning to by engage the regional and technical society YPs. IEEE is a complex organization but there is always something for everyone!

The MGA presentation to Region 10 was provided by Vice-President, Member Geographic Activities, Deepak Mathur together with Managing Director, Cecelia Jankowski. He started with the strong message that the IEEE membership is going to hit 470,000. Deepak shared his strategic plan with a vision to continue to provide quality member opportunities for continuous engagement. His 2004 focuses are:

- Member retention and progression of Students to Young Professionals
- Developing more volunteers to lead IEEE: IEEE is a volunteer led organization with the need a steady stream of qualified volunteers to lead the way
- Diversity in IEEE membership and leadership: Gender/Profession/Age/Region/Countries bringing diversity of ideas, thoughts, best practices and better perspective

Cecelia Jankowski provided the overview of the priority projects to support MGA strategic areas and goals. She encouraged the setting up of the Local Group which is Intended to be an agile and efficient forum to serve the interests of members and potential members in a local area. She also highlighted the key elements of a successful election and encouraged leaders to read the Election Policies and Procedures.

The four invited speakers took a couples of questions from the delegates:

- Prof Muhammed Kasim, Kerala Section commented on retention of student members and their membership dues. Deepak responded that with more activities, engagement and recognition at ground level will improve the student retention. Membership dues don't impact much on membership growth.
- Sudeendra Koushik commented that as a professional organisation, our retention of professional members is actually low. This is counterintuitive, especially considering that IEEE has a lot of younger volunteers and members. Fred answered that there is a focused initiative on increasing the engagement with members. In terms of involving YPs, almost every geographic OU, Society and Board has a YP representative to ensure the voice of the younger leaders are heard and strategies put in place to know more about their needs. CJ replied that the membership survey is conducted every 4 years and members are finding more time for

IEEE activities at Section level. We need to recognize members by promoting them to senior member or the grade that they are qualified for. In addition, President and President-Elect are very supportive of students and YPs. Kathleen implored us to look at our programs and the message that these programs send to the members, such as not having single gender panels, implement more industry centred activities at local level and motivated local leaders to take proactive action to engage members and industry.

Lance gave his updates and outlook for Region 10. He thanked and congratulated the Malaysia Section and leaders for hosting a successful industry event the day before. He also thanked the invited guests and delegates for their presence in this R10 annual meeting. He provided an overview of memberships for IEEE. He mentioned that R10 had a 64 time increase in membership in the past 50 years. He shared the highlights from each of the R10 committee from 2023. He welcomed the 2024 committee chairs and explained the Activities structure under 3 Vice Chairs. He reminded the delegates that R10's focus is very much aligned with the MGA objectives. Membership recruitment and retention remains the top priority for all Sections. This is achieved by enhance the values of the memberships by creating and facilitating corroborations between the various groups. He briefly mentioned the three R10 flagship conferences TENSYP, HTC and TENCON, and other activities in the coming months, such as the SYWL Congress, R10Talk and R10 Robotic Competition.

After the morning tea break, R10 Director-Elect Takako Hashimoto presented the Robert's Rules of Orders for fair and orderly meetings where everyone should have the right to speak once and only urgent matters should interrupt the speaker. She explained the Robert's Rules of Order in a summarized manner.

R10 Treasurer Nia Kurnianingsih presented the financial report for 2023. This was followed by the Audit Committee Chair Nia Kurnianingsih confirmation that all income and expenses are clearly and accurately reflected. In the OpCom meeting a day earlier, the members approved the financial report. R10 Treasurer shared the details of her 2024 budget and provided the steps to seek reimbursement for R10 meeting via Concur. Prof Toshio Fukuda asked if there was a member outside the committee to offer comments for the audit meeting. Lance and Takako responded that Kohei Ohno was an observer who was not part of the committee, and that this review was an initial internal audit. Sanjay Chowdhury asked if an event A has \$100 budgeted and event B has \$100 budgeted, and the R10 committee spends only \$70 in event A, can the \$30 be used for event B. The answer from the Audit Committee is no!

This is followed by the Region 1 Director address, Bala Prasanna spoke on the joining together current IEEE Region 1 (Northeastern U.S.) and Region 2 (Eastern U.S.) and, the splitting of current IEEE Region 10 (Asia and Pacific) into two regions. The challenges for Regions 1 and 2 are Merging two cultures, By-laws & Ops Manual, Financials (region assessment and net-worth differentials) and its implication to member services, ExCom and Board Structures, Region Award Recognitions, Professional and Student Activities Funding models, Organizational and Technical Meetings, History and Milestone events.

In the first of the 3 Invited Talks, Gora Datta spoke of the IEEE Blockchain Technical Community and its relevance to IEEE OUs. He also guided the delegates through the process of forming IEEE Blockchain Local Group. Opportunities with the IEEE BCTC include: technical collaboration, educational, tech briefs and conferences

The next segment was the presentations by the three R10 Activities Committees, namely the Professional, Membership and Technical Committees. The Vice-Chair of Professional Committee Zia

Ahmed provide the overviews of their 2024 activities. This was followed by the Committee Chairs presentation:

- Educational Activities Committee - Chi-Un Lei
- Professional Activities Committee - Daniel Eghbal
- Newsletter Committee - Akila Wijethunge

Sanjay Chowdhury enquired about a IEEE Milestone from the Kolkata Section. Takao will check and revert to him

The Meeting was moved to recess for the group photo shoot and lunch.

After lunch, the meeting resumed with 2 breakout sessions:

- IEEE Entrepreneurship by Suresh Nair, Joanne Wong, Andy Chen and Ishkandar Baharin
- Risk Management for Section Leaders by Sudeendra Koushik, followed by Conference Quality by Sameer S. M., Amit Kumar and Michael Ong

The Membership Committee Vice-Chair Rajendrasinh Jadeja provided the overview of the Membership activities and the Chairs provided the details their projects:

- Section & Chapter Committee - Amit Kumar. Amit requested the Section Chairs to appoint a Section-Chapter coordinator

The Technical Committee Vice-Chair Takao Onoye provided the overview of the Technical activities and the Chairs provided the details their projects:

The meeting then moved to recess for a coffee break together with the Poster Session where all the R10 ExCom and Ad Hoc committee chairs shared their workplans and projects interactively with the delegates.

After the break, Lance presented the IEEE Electioneering Policies and Guidelines on behalf of the IEEE Election Oversight Committee. The IEEE Policies and Procedures are the framework for consistency, and following the same standards and protocols ensures:

- unified approach in conducting election activities
- avoid potential electioneering violations
- establish boundaries and expectations
- fairness in promoting the election and its candidates

Lastly, we have Deepak the R10 Nominations & Advisory Committee Chair to share the objectives of the committee. His committee will prepare a list of potential candidates and recommend to IEEE and MGA Nominations & Appointment Committees, identify qualified candidates for the position of Region 10 Director-Elect for 2024 Elections and work for smooth transition during/after split into the Region 10 (New) and Region 11. He also provided the details of positions in IEEE and the nomination deadlines are coming up. He also presented the 3 candidates nominated by Region 10 for the 2025-2026 R10 Director-Elect election.

The Day 1 Meeting was adjourned at 4:40pm.

## **Day 2 – 3 March 2024**

Day 2 meeting commenced with a roll call for the delegates attendance.

The topic for the second invited talk was Data-based Projects Expand IEEE's Reach to Industry and it was presented by Rakesh Kumar. He provided the overview of IEEE Dataport and related initiatives. IEEE has an extensive data portfolio in IEEE Xplore, conferences and standards.

This is followed by the final invited talk by Don Tan on IEEE Industry Engagement Activities. He gave an overview of the industry engagement committee. He shared the best practices for careers and recognition:

- Make IEEE the professional home for industry professionals adding value throughout their career
- Enhance recognition to individuals and companies that have significant engagement and accomplishments within the scope of IEEE

After the tea break, R10 Treasurer Nia presented her final 2024 budget plan for Region 10 which was already approved by the R10 Operations Committee in the Audit Meeting on 1 March 2024.

Prof Toshio Fukuda pointed out that the 2024 conferences should also presented their tentative budget in this meeting for more clarity, even though the budgets are already recorded in their conference applications to MCE. Fred mentioned that the 20% surplus is just a guiding principle to ensure the

financial status is healthy. Prof Fukuda also commented that there should be a clear distinction for the R10 HTC conferences to have a humanitarian technology focus and not becoming too broad.

Finally, we have the 2025 Region 10 flagship conferences that were just approved in January 2024.
