- ❑ **ANTEM** (International Symposium on Antenna Technology and Applied Electromagnetics)  
*was acquired and hosted as an IEEE Canada Conference for the first time in 2021 in Winnipeg*
- ❑ **IHTC** (International Humanitarian Technology Conference) was inaugurated in Montreal  
*Now, A shared conference between R7 , R8, & R9 rotating through the 3 Regions*
- ❑ **HISTELCON** (HISTory of ELeCTro-technology CONference). Primarily Initiated by R8  
*Now, A shared conference between R7 , R8, R9 & R10 rotating through the Regions*

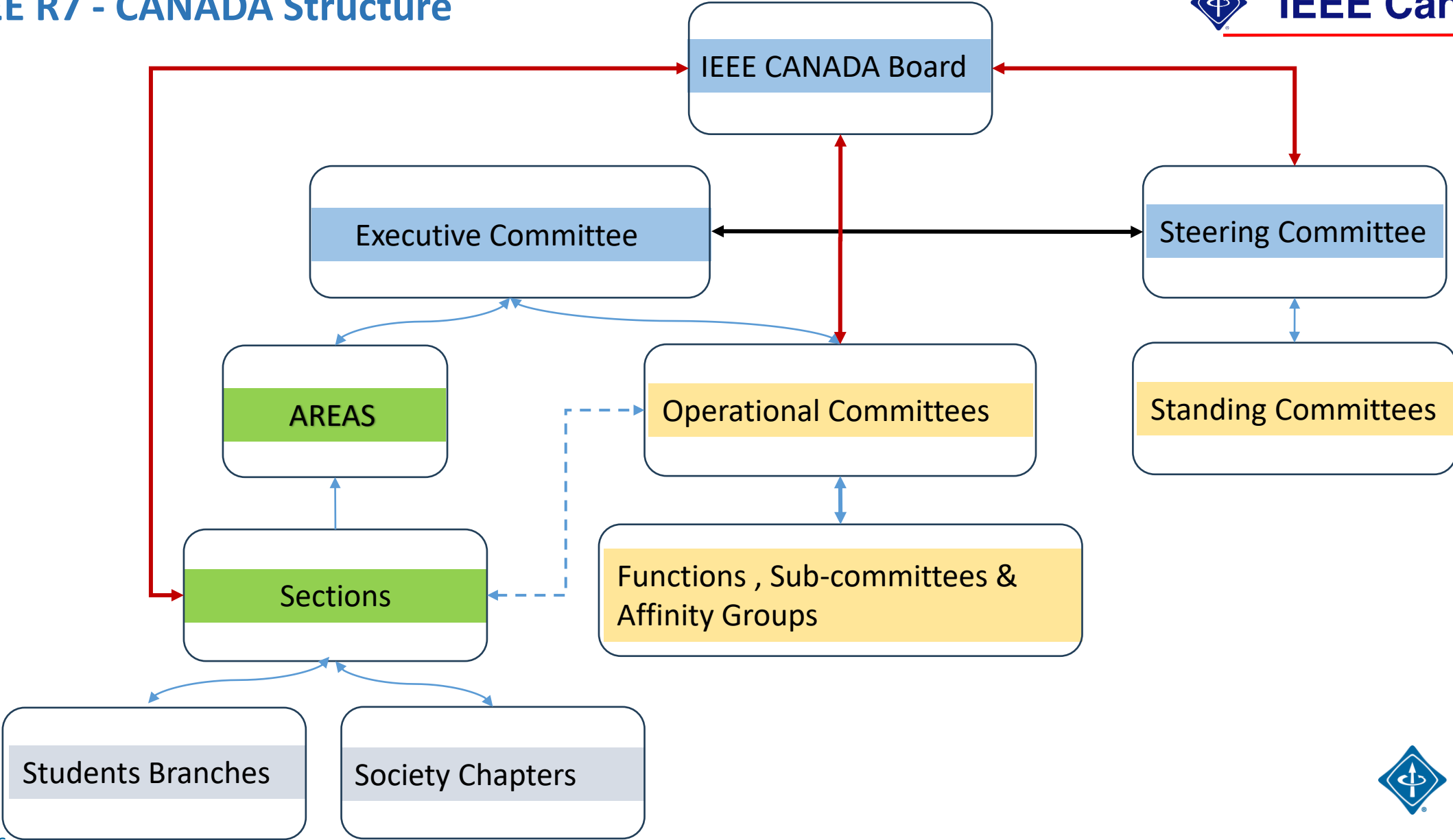
