- Call for Applications: 1st Week March 2025
- Deadline for Applications: 2nd Week April 2025
- Stage 1: July 2025 Mid August 2025
- Stage 2: Final Round October 2025

Competition Guidelines

- Open to IEEE Student Members, Graduate Student Members (GSM), and Young Professionals (YP)
- Individual or Team Participation (Max 4 members per team)
- Women in Engineering (WIE) category
- Two-Stage Competition: Virtual Evaluation & Final Round



General Rules

- Submissions should be innovative and relevant to real-world problems
- No commercial solutions unless the original work and ethical standards will be considered
- Stage 1:
 - Virtual
 - Each Section/Council/Subsection can submit 2 teams maximum
 - Registration Form, Poster, 6-Minute Video, Endorsement Letters
- Stage 2: Functional System Demonstration
 - Physical (in any unavoidable circumstances virtual)
 - Best 10 Teams (subjective to the number of applications)
 - Max. Two members from each team will be funded to participate in the final rounds from IEEE R10

Judging Criteria

- Innovation and Originality
- Practical Application and Impact
- Design and Cost-Effectiveness
- Safety and Functionality
- Presentation and Documentation Quality
- Viva and Demonstration



Prizes

- 1st Place: USD 500 + Plaque
- 2nd Place: USD 350 + Plaque
- 3rd Place: USD 250 + Certificate
- Best WIE Team: USD 150 + Certificate
- All finalists receive participation certificates

- The winning teams will be connected to any future opportunities as applicable
- Collaborations with other relevant institutions/organizations will be considered for better reach and visibility
